Wisconsin Snowmobile Registration and Trail Pass Changes Effective July 1, 2015



Registration

Registration for **each** snowmobile registered in the state of Wisconsin will be \$30 and last for 3 years.

Trail Passes

All snowmobiles operating in Wisconsin will be required to display a Wisconsin Trail Pass to operate on trails and corridors. The pass will be 3" x 3" and required to be placed on the lower center of the windshield. Trail passes are annual and need to be purchased each year.

Snowmobiles registered in the state of Wisconsin - Non-Club/AWSC Members

The Wisconsin Trail Pass is \$30 for snowmobilers who are **not** members of a snowmobile club **and** the Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs (AWSC). This pass may be ordered online or purchased at any DNR license sales agent (where hunting and fishing licenses are sold).

Snowmobiles registered in the state of Wisconsin - Club/AWSC Members

Members who belong to both a Wisconsin snowmobile club and the AWSC will be able to buy the trail pass for \$10. The discounted pass will be available for each of your Wisconsin-registered snowmobiles through the AWSC. You have to be current with AWSC to obtain a discounted trail pass. The snowmobile clubs will continue to be responsible for collecting your AWSC membership dues.

Snowmobiles **NOT registered in the state of Wisconsin regardless of Club/AWSC Membership**

Trail pass fees will increase from \$35 to \$50 per year. There is no discounted option for trail passes. This pass may be ordered online or purchased at any DNR license sales agent (where hunting and fishing licenses are sold).

Revenue generated from the sale of snowmobile registrations and Wisconsin Trail Passes goes to the segregated snowmobile account which is used to maintain and develop Wisconsin's snowmobile trails.

Wisconsin snowmobile trails are made possible by snowmobile club volunteers who provide the labor to brush, sign and groom the trails and the landowners who allow trails to cross their property.

Additional changes will allow resident owners of snowmobiles 35 years and older (currently 1980 and older) to register as antiques and receive a free annual trail pass.

Join the Relic Riders Snowmobile Club and qualify for a discount. Annual Associate Membership Dues for the Relic Riders Club are \$25.00 and includes \$10.00 AWSC membership.
